## DIRECTORATE GENERAL OF AERONAUTICAL QUALITY ASSURANCE

New Delhi, the 5th January, 2007

S.R.O. 1.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the (1) Directorate of Technical Development and Production (Air) Organization Group 'B' Gazetted Recruitment Rules, 1980, (2) Directorate of Technical Development and Production (Air) Class-III Technical, Scientific and other non-ministerial posts Recruitment Rules, 1972 in so far as they relate to the post of Senior Scientific Assistant and Chief Draughtsman and (3) Directorate of Technical Development and Production (Air) Organization Group 'C' Non-Gazetted (Technical Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1993 in so far as they relate to the post of Foreman, except as respect of things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to certain Group-'B' Gazetted posts in the Directorate General of Aeronautical Quality Assurance [in the erstwhile Directorate of Technical Development and Production (Air)] in the Department of Defence Production under Ministry of Defence, namely :—

## 1. Short Title and commencement:—

- (1) These Rules may be called the Directorate General of Aeronautical Quality Assurance, Department of Defence Production, Group-'B' Gazetted (Technical/Scientific) Post Recruitment Rules, 2007.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

## 2. Application : They shall apply to the posts mentioned under column 1 in the Schedule attached to these rules.

3. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.—The number of posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the after said Schedule.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit, other qualifications etc.—The method of recruitment age limit, educational qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (14) of the said Schedule.

5. Initial constitution.—The incumbents of the post of Senior Scientific Assistant (Higher Scale) in the establishment of Directorate of Technical Development and Production (Air) were initially recruited as Senior Scientific Assistants and are governed by SRO 217 published in Gazette of India dated 5th August, 1972, Ministry of Defence, Government of India Part-II, Section 4 and are continued to function as such in pursuance of the arbitration award OA Number 883/99, dated 24 September, 1991 of the CAT, Hyderabad Bench, as per which 42 officers are holding the post of Senior Scientific Assistant (Higher Scale) on regular basis in Group 'B' Gazetted cadre on the date of commencement of these rules since reclassified as Group 'B' Gazetted cadre along with Foreman and Chief Draftsman in August, 1994 Vide Government of India, Ministry of Defence, Department of Defence Production and Supplies letter number 4741/Reclass/ DTD&P (Air)/Admn.-III/817/11/94/D(HAL), dt. 26th August, 1994 and they shall be deemed to have been recruited under these rules and the regular and continuous services rendered by them shall be taken into consideration for the purpose of promotion to the higher post.

## 6. Disqualification.—No person,—

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for the appointment to any of the said posts :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

7. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with Union Public Service Commission relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

8. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

(The subjects required will be indicated at the time of each recruitment)

Desirable : Two years experience in Quality Assurance or Inspection or Production or Development in areas of discipline related to aircraft and its accessories.

Note 1: Qualification are relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission in case of candidates otherwise well qualified.

Note 2: The qualification(s) regarding experience is/are relaxable at the discretion of Union Public Service Commission in case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe, if at any stage of selection the Union Public Service Commission is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the posts reserved for them.

in the pay scale of Rs. 6500—10500 with three years regular service in the grade and possessing Degree in Science or Diploma in Engineering or Technology or Draughtsmanship.

Note 1: A ratio of 2:1 shall be followed for promotion from officers holding the posts of Senior Scientific Assistant (Higher Scale) on the one hand and from the combined strength of officers holding the post of Foreman and Chief Draughtsman.

Note 2 : Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

Deputation : Officers under the Central or State Govts. or Union Territories or Universities or Recognised Research Institutions or Public Sector Undertakings or Semi Government or Statutory or Autonomous Organisations :—

- (a) (i) holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent cadre or department; or
- (ii) with two years' service in the grade redered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the scale of pay of Rs. 7450—11500 or Requivalent in the parent cadre or department; or



(iii) with three years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the scale of pay of Rs. 6500—10500 or equivalent in the parent cadre or department; and

(b) possessing the Educational Qualification and experience prescribed for direct recruits under column 8.

Note 1 : The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note 2 : Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years'. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years', as on the closing date of receipt of applications.
